

HAZARD COMMUNICATION

Training for Managers, Supervisors, and Team Leaders

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This instructor-led program introduces managers, supervisors, and team leaders to the requirements of the Hazard Communication Standard and provides an introduction into chemical hazard recognition. This will help participants to recognize chemical hazards, allowing them to implement an effective program to inform and protect the workforce.

Key elements of this program include: reviewing the requirements of a hazard communication program, understanding health and physical hazards, interpreting labels and MSDSs, and common control methods.

This is intended as a half-day program to provide a foundation for individuals responsible for developing and implementing a hazard control program. The sessions can be condensed and presented with other topics as part of new employee or annual refresher training.

OBJECTIVES

Participants will be able to develop/revise their hazard communication program with an increased understanding of the requirements of the standard, awareness of chemical hazards,

knowledge of methods to reduce potential exposures.
