## SAFETY LEADERSHIP TRAINING

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This instructor-led training program provides managers, supervisors and team leaders with the knowledge and tools to be effective leaders in the safety process. The focus is on improving their day-to-day behavior to help prevent workplace injuries within their work groups. The course effectively balances instruction of state-of-the art accident prevention and behavioral concepts with practical discussions of workplace safety issues.

Key elements of the program are: identification of current workplace safety issues and the development of personal safety action plans.

The duration of the full course is 6-8 hours, depending on the amount of customization to meet the client's specific needs. A two-hour version is available which indoctrinates the management team or line personnel in the basic safety principles highlighted below.
